TASKS / TIME LIMITS / SCORING

Kit Check: Contestants will be able to present to the judges all required items are supplied as instructed. Student Kit Check (KIT CHECK FOR only sections 2 (H-R) IN TECHNICAL STANDARDS) (50 points)

Oral Communication: Contestants will deliver a 3-4 minute oral explanation on their choice of two options. Option A is the theme choice, development and methods of application of the fantasy make-up application and option B is an explanation of client consultation characteristics, uses and methods. **NOTE CARDS OR PROPS NOT ACCEPTABLE** (100 points)

Basic Facial: Contestants will perform a basic facial service on a live model including all necessary pre- and post-service procedures within a 45 minute time limit. (190 points)

Facial massage: After Basic Facial Contestants will perform a facial massage on a live model including all necessary pre-and post-service procedures within a 15 minute time limit. (180 points) Once all Judges see facial being demonstrated they will be asked to stop.

Daytime Cosmetic Application: Kit Check: Contestants will be able to present to the judges all required items are supplied as instructed. (kit check only section 2: F, G, I) listed in Technical Standards (50 Points)

Contestants will perform a daytime cosmetic application on a live model including all necessary pre- and post-service procedures within a 60 minute time limit. (165 points)

Fantasy Make-up Application: Contestants will perform a fantasy make-up application on a live model including all necessary pre- and post- service procedures within a 60 minute time limit. (165 points)

Resume and / or clothing penalties may result in point deductions.
All contestants must be in uniform during designated contest times up to (-50)

Written Examination: Contestants will have 45 minutes on a 50 question written assessment based on knowledge of esthetics. (100 points)

Special Notice

Sterilization and Sanitation Procedures / Safety: Proper measures of client protection will be monitored throughout all performance skills.

Note changes to the Written Test portions of the competition, Changes have been made to the fantasy contest; changes have been made to the Facial Massage portion of the competition
